Accessing the internet from your wireless laptop

Connect to Guest Wireless using Windows Vista/Win 7

1. Click on **Start**
2. Click **Control Panel**
3. Click on **Network and Sharing Center**
4. On the left click on **Manage Wireless Networks**
5. Click on **Add**
6. Click **Manually create a network profile**
7. Underneath Network Name type in **GUEST** (use caps)
8. Set Security type to **No authentication (Open)**
9. Set Encryption type to **None**
10. Leave Security Key blank
11. Choose the option **Start this connection automatically**
12. Choose the option **Connect even if the network is not broadcasting**
13. Click **Next**
14. Click **Close**
15. Wait for your computer to establish the connection (Windows tends to tell you when you connect to a network).
16. Open Internet Explorer, once connected, and you'll be prompted with the OSF disclaimer. **With Win 7 you may get a firewall message – click 'Continue to this website'**
17. Scroll to the bottom of the webpage and click **I accept the terms**
18. The internet should now be available.

Connect to Guest Wireless using Windows XP SP2

1. Confirm your laptop has wireless hardware and software installed, connected and turned on.
2. Click on **Start --- Settings --- Control Panel --- Network Connections.**
3. In the **Network Connections** window double click on **Wireless Network Connections.**
4. In the **Wireless Network Connection Status** right click for **Properties.**
5. In the **Wireless Network Connection Properties** windows click on **Wireless Networks** tab at the top of the window.
6. Click the **Add** button.
7. In the **Wireless Network Properties** windows complete the following information:
 - A. **Association Tab**
 1. Network name (SSID) - **GUEST** (GUEST must be in all caps.)
 2. Network Authentication - **Open**
 3. Data encryption - **Disabled**
 - B. **Authentication Tab** - Make sure there is nothing checked on this page
 - C. **Connection Tab** - Check the box **Connect when this network is in range**
 - D. Click the **OK** button.
8. Click the **OK** button.
9. Allow 30 seconds to 1 minute for the wireless connection to be established.
10. Scroll to the bottom of the webpage and click **I accept the terms**
11. The internet should now be available.
